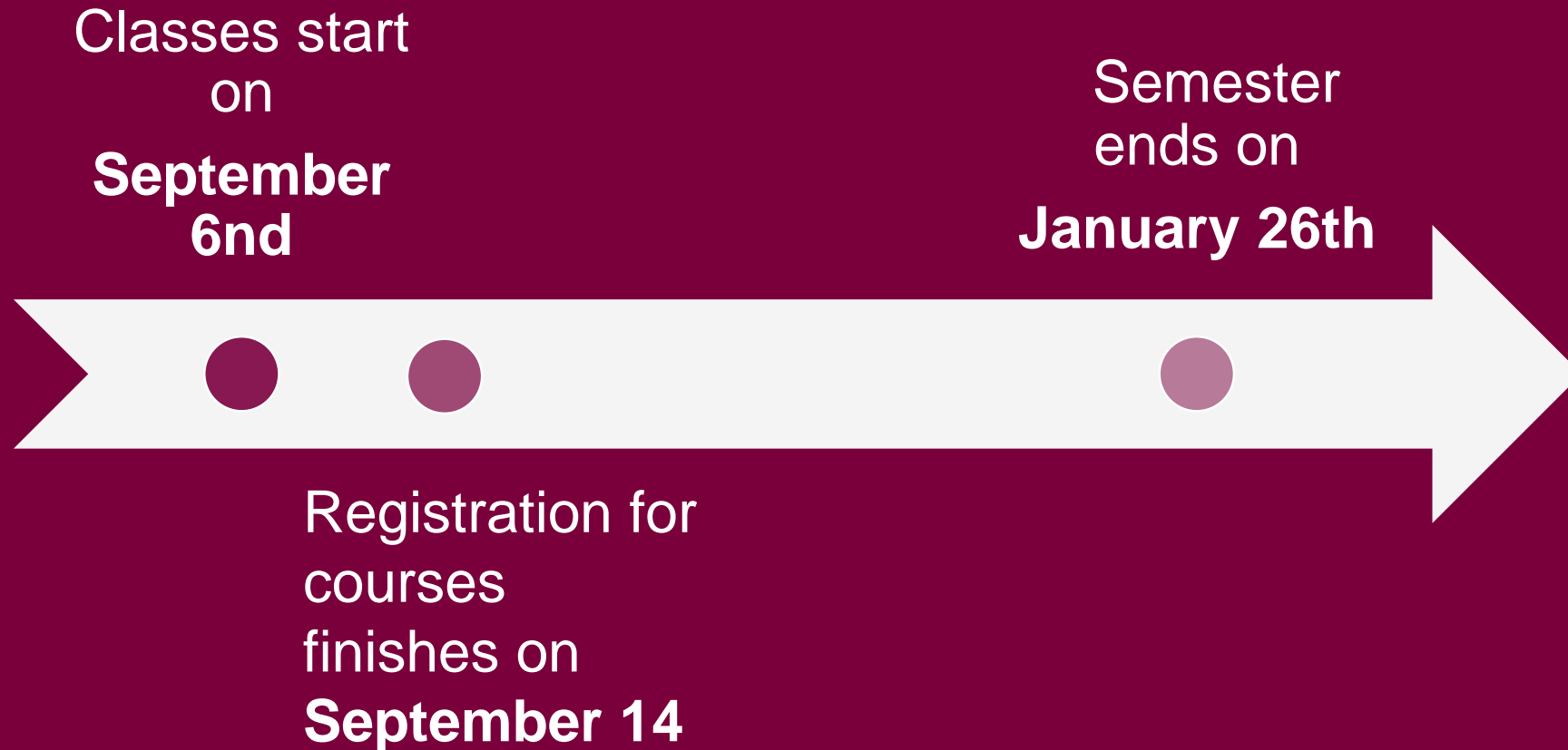

Semester timeline

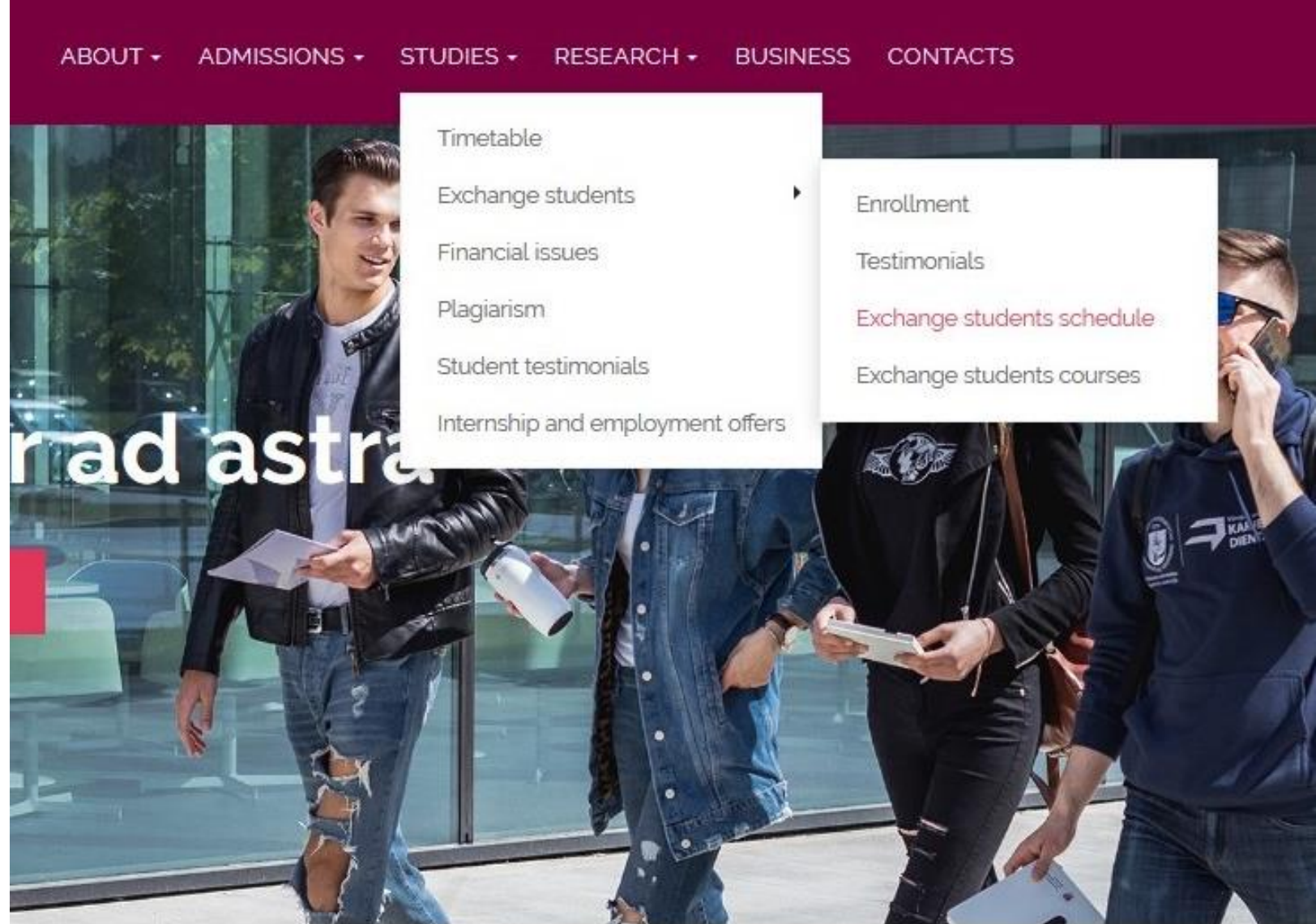
