Annotation

This course covers the theoretical and practical issues of state economic policy: the goals and the factors of its formation, the role of the state in the regulation of economic processes and the impact of regulation on economic growth. The main areas of economic regulation are investigated: reduction of poverty and social exclusion, labor market policies, consumer protection and competition policies, environmental policies, investment climate formation and investment policies, foreign trade policies. Particular attention is paid to case studies: the examination of economic policy measures of the EU member states and in the other countries of the world.

Topics:

- The importance, goals and measures of economic regulation. OECD Principles for Better Regulation.
- Assessing the interaction between the benefits and costs of economic regulation.
- Regulation and economic growth. Tax policies to promote inclusive growth.
- The main areas of economic regulation: reduction of poverty and social exclusion, labor market policies, consumer protection and competition policies, environmental policies, investment climate formation and investment policies, foreign trade policies.

- Essay on a chosen topic of economic policy and regulation (40%);
