- You are automatically registered for the courses indicated on your LA before arrival;
- If you want to choose courses that were not on your initial LA, we will accept you to the course provided we have enough places left (you will see remaining places on VU IS);
- Check the pre-requisites of the course so that you are sure you are eligible to follow the course;
- **PLEASE NOTE:** choose the courses from the Faculty that has an agreement with your home University, exchange students can choose not more than 15 ECTS from other Faculties.

- ✓ All Spring semester 2020-2021 classes will start **online** using virtual learning environment (Moodle) for sharing the course materials and MsTeams or ZOOM conference platforms for live lectures, seminars and consultations;

- ✓ All information about online lectures should be reflected on the timetable, but please check your Moodle regularly, lecturers will share the most relevant information about their course there too;

# How to read the timetable?

- The timetable is a daily reflection of different classes, so check it weekly;
- Lectures usually take place every week, whereas seminars are organised every other week;
- On the timetable you will clearly see:
  - if is a **lecture** or a **seminar**;
  - the **date** and **time** of the course;
  - who the **lecturer** is (sometimes lectures and seminars are organised by two different lecturers);
  - All the courses in the English language are delivered online: there is a comment „Takes Place Remotely“



## Master level courses:

- ✓ Organised in Modules, some courses may be intensive, please check the timetable;
- ✓ Always in evenings (some classes may even be on Saturdays);
- ✓ A VERY limited number of students can be accepted to these courses, please make it sure you register as early as possible.
- ✓ **VERY IMPORTANT: Master level courses can be attended only by Master level students.**  
If it is absolutely necessary for a Bachelor level student to attend a Master level course - please contact FEBA coordinator **erasmus@evaf.vu.lt** in advance to discuss the situation and look for a possible solution.
