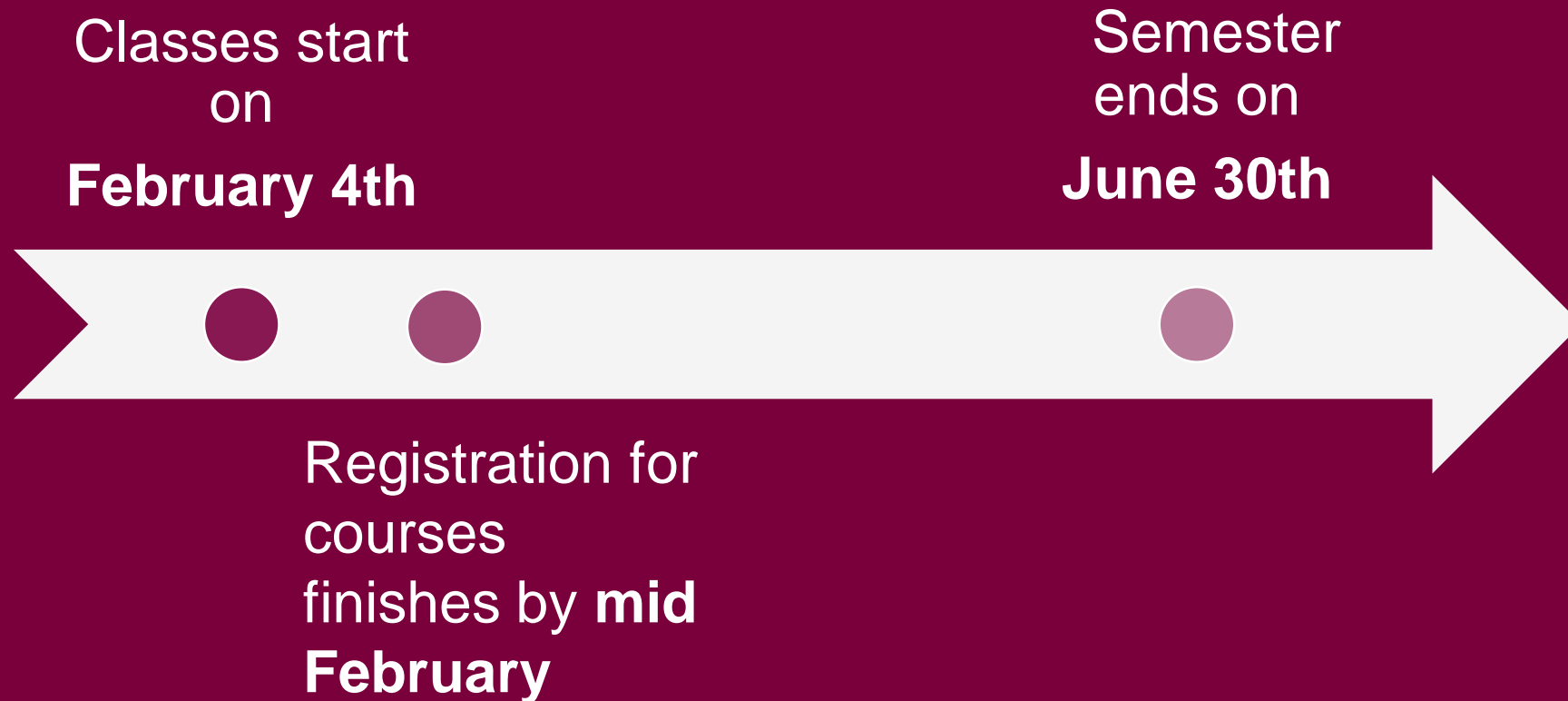

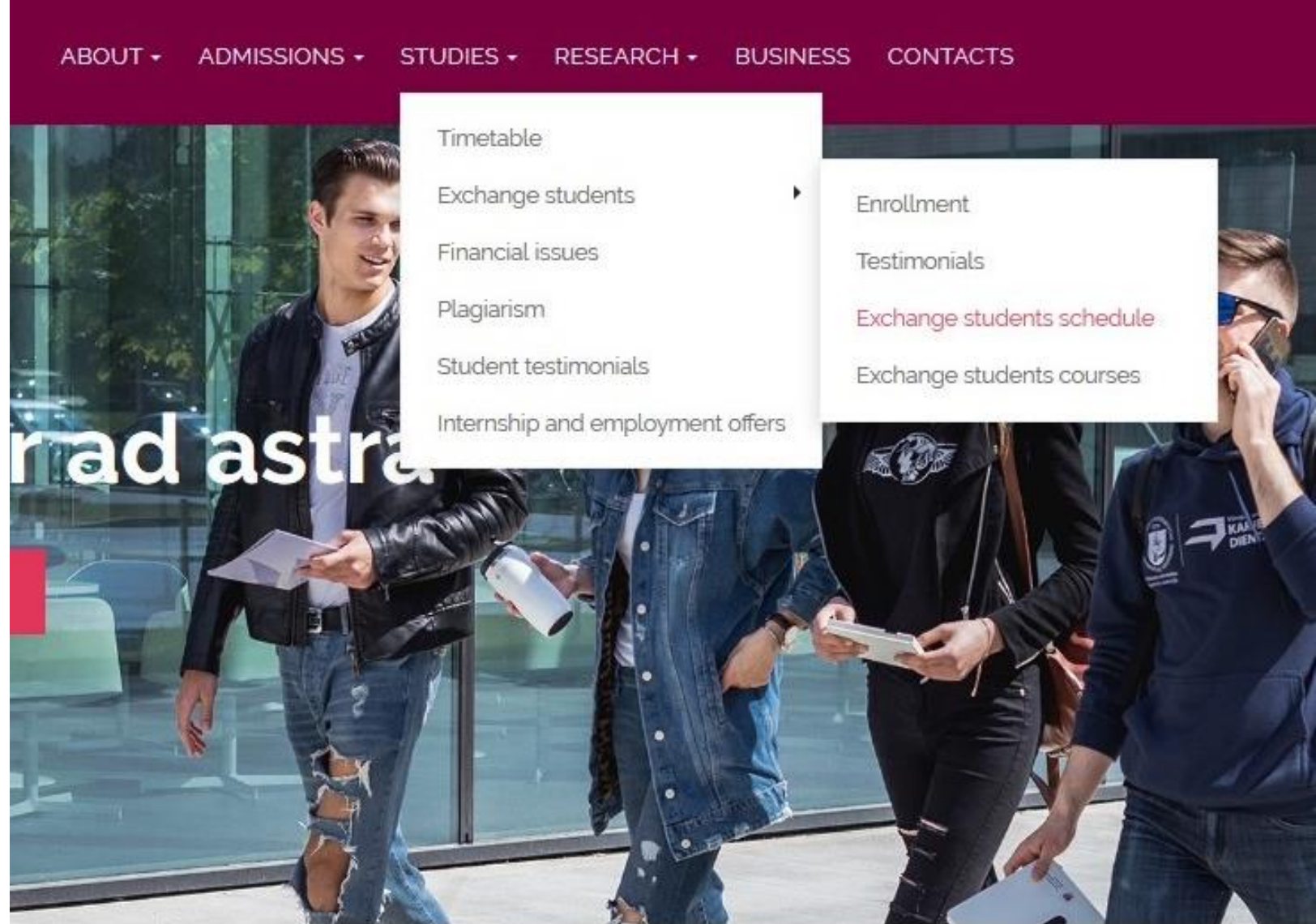

General tips



- ✓ Do NOT be late for classes and exams! Please NOTE: if it is written that a lecture starts at 10 a.m., we mean it does start at 10 a.m., not at 10:30 a.m 😊
- ✓ Communicate with your lecturers: if you are not able to come to a class or exam, warn professors in advance;
- ✓ Class lasts 1,5 hour (even though it is written 12.00-14.00)
- ✓ Follow the timetables by yourself: please note that even though the majority of BA courses follow general timetable patterns, there are some courses (esp. those of **Quantitative Economics**) where timetable has to be checked weekly;
- ✓ Meet with the coordinator during office hours or even better – e-mail her 😊



Master level courses

- ✓ Organised in Modules, some courses may be intensive;
- ✓ Always in evenings (sometimes on Saturdays);
- ✓ **Only Master** (Graduate) level students can attend;
- ✓ A VERY limited number of students can be accepted to these courses, please make it sure you register as early as possible;
- ✓ Registration Forms signed by the International Students' Coordinator in Room 412

- ✓ Exam session is **strictly** regulated at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration;
- ✓ Early exam session is allowed only when a student has a grounded reason that can be supported by documentation (illness, study process regulations at home University, etc.);
- ✓ **The lecturer cannot take the decision:** a separate request form has to be submitted to the Studies Department (Room 412) with the supporting documentation by April 15th
