- Please check the pre-requisites of the course so that you are sure you are eligible to follow the course;
- **VERY IMPORTANT: Master level courses can be attended only by Master level students.**
If it is absolutely necessary for a Bachelor level student to attend a Master level course - please contact FEBA coordinator erasmus@evaf.vu.lt in advance to discuss the situation and look for a possible solution, otherwise you will be removed from these courses.

How to read the timetable?

- The timetable is a daily reflection of different classes, so check it weekly;
- Lectures usually take place every week, whereas seminars are organised every other week;
- On the timetable you will clearly see:
 - if is a **lecture** or a **seminar**;
 - the **date** and **time** of the course;
 - who the **lecturer** is (sometimes lectures and seminars are organised by two different lecturers);
 - All the courses in the English language are delivered online: words NUOTOLINIU BŪDU in the comment section mean DELIVERED DISTANTLY

- ✓ Always in evenings (some classes may even be on Saturdays);
- ✓ **Only Master** (Graduate) level students can attend;
- ✓ A VERY limited number of students can be accepted to these courses, please make it sure you register as early as possible.
