Registration For Courses at FEBA

- You are automatically registered for the courses indicated on your LA before arrival, so the place in these courses is secured for you;
- If you want to make some changes and decide to choose courses that were not on your initial LA, we will accept you to the course provided we have enough places left (you will see remaining places on VU IS);
- Please check the pre-requisites of the course so that you are sure you are eligible to follow the course;
- **VERY IMPORTANT: Master level courses can be attended only by Master level students.**

If it is absolutely necessary for a Bachelor level student to attend a Master level course - please contact FEBA coordinator erasmus@evaf.vu.lt in advance to discuss the situation and look for a possible solution.

Important information on the study process in 2021-2022

- ✓ Lecturers are encouraged to deliver Fall semester 2021-2022 lectures **online** using virtual learning environment (Moodle) for sharing the course materials and MsTeams or ZOOM conference platforms; seminars – in-class with possible live streaming;
- ✓ **In-class activities can be joint only by immunised students (proof needed);**
- ✓ Please activate and check regularly your VU E-MAIL, it will often be used for MsTeams conferences;
- ✓ All information about online/in-class lectures should be reflected on the timetable, but please check your Moodle regularly, lecturers will share the most relevant information about their courses there too;
- ✓ Please communicate any kind of problems that you face with the Faculty coordinator **by email**, when there is a need we may schedule an individual meeting face-to-face or via online conference platforms.



Exam session at FEBA:

- There is no exam session for Master level courses – all modules end with exam during semester dates;
- We are not yet sure how exam session will be organised for Bachelor level courses - we hope for in-class exams in January;
- Early Exam session in December: requests accepted till November 15th (documents proving the need are required);
- Early exam session will not be organised if exams are to be conducted via online tools.



How to read the timetable?

- The timetable is a daily reflection of different classes, so check it weekly;
- Lectures usually take place every week, whereas seminars are organised every other week;
- On the timetable you will clearly see:
 - if is a **lecture** or a **seminar**;
 - the **date** and **time** of the course;
 - who the **lecturer** is (sometimes lectures and seminars are organised by two different lecturers);
 - Some courses will be organised remotely, some in-class
