- **Where can I find the timetable?**

Courses for exchange students are clearly separated on the first line in the “GUE and Erasmus” section as ERASMUS\_BACHELORS (ENGLISH) – Bachelor’s level courses and ERASMUS\_MASTERS (ENGLISH) – Master’s level courses.

- **Where will the class take place?**

If you fail to find the place of the course, please try to seek for help of other classmates/mentors/friends. If you still cannot find the room where the lecture is planned, please come to the faculty coordinators. In order to fasten the processes, please make it sure you have the title of the course and the name of the professor with you.

- **How to register for Bachelor courses?**

In order to successfully register for the course, students need to get the faculty coordinator's signature on the Registration Form (the form is provided by the International Relations Office). Please visit the Faculty coordinator in Room 412.

- **How to register for Master courses?**

There is a limited number of students who can attend the courses, therefore registration is **mandatory**. Please visit the Faculty coordinator in Room 412.

Please keep it in mind that at FEBA all Master courses are intensive and they are organized in modules. Usually, one course lasts for 2 – 3 weeks and finishes with exam. If the course is delivered by a visiting professor, the classes may take place every day a week (Monday-Friday), sometimes on Saturdays too. The classes are organized in the evenings, so please have it in mind when you prepare your study programme.

**VERY VERY Important:** Only Master students can attend Master level courses. However, if there is such a need and your home University approves of, Master students are allowed to choose Bachelor level courses (BUT not vice versa).

- **Do you want to change the course in your learning agreement?**

Faculty coordinator will not sign your learning agreements.

- **Can I have all my exams before the official exam session?**

Exam session is strictly regulated at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration and early exam session is allowed only when a student has a grounded reason that can be supported by documentation (illness, study process regulations at home University, etc.);

PLEASE NOTE, the lecturer cannot take the decision: a separate request form has to be submitted to the Studies Department (Room 412) with the supporting documentation **by November 15th (for Autumn semester) and by April 15th (for Spring semester)**.
